CALL TO ORDER

The Stated Meeting of the Session for the month of April 2022 was called to order by Moderator, Rev. Dr. Jeff Hosmer, at 1:00 pm on April 19, 2022. A quorum was declared. Pastor Jeff opened the meeting with prayer and the welcoming of new Church Administrator, Dave Belch.

CALL FOR NEW BUSINESS AND APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Moderator Hosmer inquired if there were any new action items that need to be added to the agenda. There being none, the agenda was approved as distributed. Later in the meeting an additional action item was added regarding the APNC which is action number 4.

Pastor Jeff introduced the new church Administrator Dave Belch. Dave Belch will be replacing Tom Ledoux. The positions will be overlapping for several months. Tom Ledoux gave some background information regarding Dave who is from Ontario, Canada. Dave Belch then spoke regarding his and his wife, Jane, decision for accepting God's call of this position and information regarding family, educational and past ministries.

ACTION ITEMS

1. A motion was made to approve the minutes of the March 15, 2022, regular Session meeting as distributed. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

- 2. A motion was made to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2022, Session meeting to receive new members. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously. A copy of the minutes is attached.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORTS

Financial Report

Giving for the month of March was \$164,736 which is 11% less than the budget. Giving through the month of March is under budget by \$27,167. (-5%)

Expenses for March were under budget by \$5,291 which resulted in a surplus of \$6,658. The YTD surplus is \$60,722.

The loan on the long-term mortgage rate is being negotiated with bank and the papers should be signed next week by President Rose Gorman and Secretary Dick Young.

The "Count Me In Campaign" has a balance of \$76,444. The Finance Committee will probably recommend within the next few months that some of the balance of this campaign be applied to pay down some of the mortgage loan.

Operation Homebound revenue in March was under budget by \$1,439 and expenses were \$1,898 over budget. The deficit for March was \$12,903 and the YTD deficit is \$32,977.

Little Blessings tuition revenue in March was over budget by \$2,345 and expenses were \$529 under budget. The March deficit was \$1,347 and the YTD deficit is \$12,313. Pastor Shawn Smith reported that Little Blessings received a federal grant in the amount of \$82,613.70 which will be distributed in three installments during the next year. The first installment has already been received in the amount of \$27,537.90.

The Christian Food Pantry expenditures were under budget for the month of March. The YTD deficit of \$20,859 is less than the projected deficit. We are still in the process of soliciting bids for the expansion and renovation project.

Personnel

Mason Copeland, who at one time participated in our Student Ministry, has been hired as a part time chef for Operation Homebound.

CLERK'S REPORT

No report was received by the Clerk of Session.

Pastor Jeff pointed out that upcoming Presbytery meeting will be held via Zoom on June 2, 2022, at 2:00 PM. The featured speaker will be Tod Bolsinger, author of "Canoeing the Mountains."

OTHER REPORTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

- The Session meetings, until further notice, will begin at 2:00 PM in the Grace Room. There will be no meeting of Session in July unless it is necessary.
- Elder Bill Johnston made the motion to dissolve the APNC committee which is listed in the action items.
- Pastor Jeff shared his observations and thoughts with Session for (1) currently thankful for NLPC (2) next three months and (3) the next three years. Pastor Jeff stated that Pastor Lynn will be retiring at the end of March 2023. The complete list of his observations is attached.

A motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously to adjourn the meeting with prayer which was led by Pastor Shawn 3:40 PM.
